

Notice of Location of Bonanza Lode by Schmand & Weiler

The Bonanza Lode Bonanza claim
 Notice is hereby given that the undersigned having com-
 plied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title thirty
 two of the Revised Statutes of the United States and the
 local customs laws and regulations, has located fif-
 teen hundred linear feet on the Bonanza lode, situated in
 Green River Mining District State of Washington and de-
 scribed as follows: Beginning at a stake three hundred
 linear feet north of Discovery stake, said discovery stake
 being on the first cliff on Lake Creek, said creek being the
 second creek below Grand Canyon, emptying into Green
 River from the south side thence seven hundred and
 fifty linear feet in a westerly direction to a stake, thence
 south six hundred linear feet to a stake, passing at three
 hundred linear feet a stake indicating center of lode
 thence east fifteen hundred linear feet to a stake,
 thence north six hundred linear feet to a stake, passing
 at three hundred linear feet a stake indicating center of
 lode, thence west seven hundred and fifty linear feet to
 place of beginning, including all dips, spurs, crooks, and
