

Notice of Location of The Lost-Hope Lode Claim No 2

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirteenth of the Revised Statutes of the United States, and the local customs laws and regulations has located fifteen hundred linear feet on the Lost-Hope Lode, situated in St. Helens Mining District State of Washington and described as follows.

Beginning at a post in center of Lode and in center of Boulder Gulch about 50 feet above foot high cliff in said Gulch on the South Side of Goat Mountain about 1/2 mile in an North Westby direction from the Black Jack on Green River also known as the North fork of the Toutle River thence Three hundred linear feet in an Southby direction to a stake, Thence Fifteen hundred linear feet in an Westby direction to a stake, Thence Six hundred linear feet in an Northby direction to a stake passing at 200 linear feet a stake indicating center of lode Thence Fifteen hundred linear feet in an Eastby direction to a stake Thence Three hundred linear feet in an Southby direction to place of beginning, including all its dips, spurs, cracks and angles.
