

Notice of Location The Carbonate lode, Claim No. 1

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Twenty-two of the Revised Statutes of the U. S. and the local customs laws and regulations, has located fifteen hundred linear feet on the Carbonate lode, situated in St. Helens Mining District, State of Washington, and described as follows:

Beginning at a stake at the foot of a cliff in the center of Rock Gulch, on the South Slope of Goat Mountain and directly opposite, and across the North Fork of Toutle River from Lone Creek, thence running three hundred linear feet in a South westerly direction to a stake, thence running fifteen hundred linear feet in a South easterly direction to a stake, thence six hundred linear feet in a North easterly direction to a stake passing at three hundred linear feet a stake, indicating center of lode, thence fifteen hundred linear feet in a North westerly direction to a stake, thence three hundred feet in a South westerly direction to place of beginning.
