 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
 and Eighty four between Mary Weiser of the
 County of Skamania Territory of Washington the
 party of the first part and John Runyan
 of Wasco County State of Oregon the party of the
 second part Witnesseth that the said party of
 the first part is justly indebted to the said
 party of the second part in the sum of
 thirty five Dollars Gold Coin of the United
 States of America upon a certain promissory note
 made at the date hereof by the said party of the
 first part to and in favor of the party of the
 second part in the words and figures following
 to wit Oct-3^d 1884 Six Months after date
 without grace I promise to pay to John Runyan
 or order the sum of thirty five dollars payable
 in gold coin of the Government of the United States
 for Value Received without Interest Mary x Weiser
 Now this Deed Witnesseth that for the purpose
 of securing the payment of the said promissory
 note the said party of the first part for and in
 consideration of the premises as also in
 consideration of the sum of one dollar lawful
 money to her in hand paid by the said party
 of the second part the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged has granted bargain
 sold conveyed and confirmed and does hereby
 grant bargain sell convey and confirm unto
 the said party of the second part his heirs
 and assigns all of her homestead claim situated
 in sec 32 Twp 3 N. R. 8 E Willamette Meradia
 in Skamania County Washington Territory
 containing Seventeen and $\frac{65}{100}$ acres be the
 same more or less Together with the all
 and singular the tenements hereditaments
 and appurtenances thereto belonging
 or in any wise appertaining to have and
 to hold the said premises with all the
 tenements appurtenances hereditaments
 thereunto belonging unto the said party
