Notice is hereby given that Robert Foddyer, of White Salmon, County of Klickitat, State of Oregon Washington, claims a lien on a quantity of lumber and ties, being about four hundred thousand feet in quantity, which was cut and manufactured in Skamania County Washington, and is now lying near the mill of the above named Stepp Brothers Lumber Company, Pleasant in said County of Skamania, State of Washington and along the flume from said Mill to the Columbia River and on the beach of said River and near the end of said flume, all being in the said County of Skamania, and State of Washington, said lien being claimed for labor performed and materials rendered in connection with the manufacture and preparation of said lumber in said County and State: That the name of the owner of the quantity of said lumber and ties is Stepp Brothers Lumber Company; that they employed said Robert Foddyer to perform such labor and to render such services upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit: That said Stepp Brothers Lumber Co. agreed to pay the said Robert Foddyer for such labor and services the sum of five dollars (\$5.00) per day; that the said Robert Foddyer worked in pursuance of the said contract of employment ninety three (93) days and that the said contract has been faithfully performed and complied with on the part of the said Robert Foddyer. That said labor and services were performed and rendered before the 11th day of July 1907 and the 29th day of October 1907 and the rendering of the said services was closed on the 29th day of October 1907, and that days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimants demand for said services is \$465.00, that as yet thereof has been paid except the sum of \$187.24 and there are now due and owing against them, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$287.76, in which amount he claims a lien upon the said lumber.
