

Notice of Relocation Gray Eagle by Washington Mill & Mining Co.
 Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States, and the local customs, laws and regulations, has Relocated Lignite land owned by six hundred linear feet on the Gray Eagle quartz lode, situated on the South Side of Blue Bird Creek in Washington Mining District (Unorganized) County of Idemania, Wash, and described as follows:

On South side of said Blue Bird Creek about 2 miles from junction with Washington river and about 300 yards up said "B B" Creek above mouth of Creek intersecting said Blue Bird Creek on North side: and about 1/2 mile below first falls on said Blue Bird creek: said ledge cropping out in creek bottom and up gulch made by land erosion: the lines of said claim being as follows:

Beginning at discovery post where Notice is posted and running 300 feet in a westerly direction to post marked NW cor SE: thence 300 feet in a southerly direction to corner post marked S.W. cor SE: thence in an easterly direction 300 feet to South corner end post of said claim: thence easterly 300 to corner post marked S.E. cor SE: thence Northerly 1500 to cor post marked NE cor SE: thence westerly 300 feet to place of beginning.
