Childers according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands, " and the acts supplemental thereto for the north east quarter of the north west quarter and the lots numbered one, two and three of section thirty in township three north of range ten east of Willamette Meridian in Washington Territory, containing one hundred and fifty four acres.

according to the Official plat of the Survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said William L. Childers.
