H. E. Person Agent, who, being duly sworn, says that at
least (\$600,) Six Hundred Dollars worth of labor or improve-
ments were performed or made upon the "Blue Jacket" and
"Pickapoos" quartz lodes. (contiguous) and the "Long Eagle"
lode, in some group, and adjoining said claims on the
east, said expenditures and labor being for the development
of all these claims jointly, said claims being recorded at
Stevenson, (the County Seat of Skamania Co) and situated in
Cold Mountain Mining District Skamania County, State of
Washington during the year ending Dec 31st, 1896.

Such expenditures were made by or at the expense of The
Crackhough Mill & Mining Co composed of J. P. White, H. E. Person
Douglas Caples & E. M. Cox, owners of said claims for the
purpose of holding said claims. Said work consisted of
building trails, labor on tunnel (30 feet), building cabin and
constructing stockhead, said claims being upon Blue Bird
Creek a tributary of the Crackhough river.
