

Claim for Lien.

L. P. McCroskey and Sons Lumber Company, Claimant vs. Washougal River Improvement Company.

Notice is hereby given that on the seventh day of May 1907, claimant herein, at the special instance and request of the Washougal River Improvement Company acting through its manager J. A. Buckley, commenced to furnish sawed lumber, planks, and timbers to the said Washougal River Improvement Company. Said lumber, planks, and timbers were used by said company in the construction of a bunk and cook house, and of what is known as an upper and lower dam, and across the Washougal river, Skamania County, Washington. Said bunk and cook house and the upper dam are situated on the South-East quarter of Sec. thirty-one Township three North, Range Six East W.M. Said lower dam is situated partly on Southwest quarter Sec. thirty-three Township two North, Range five East W.M., and partly on North-west quarter of the same section township and range.

That the name of the owner and reputed owner of the above described dams and cook and bunk house is and all times herein was, Washougal River Improvement Company; that the said Washougal Improvement Company leased the land on which the upper dam, bunk and cook house, are erected, from Hiram Sibley, said Sibley being the owner and reputed owner of said land.

That the undersigned claims a lien on said bunk and cook house for the sum of \$25.00 and on said lower dam for the sum of \$23.59, and on said upper dam for the sum of \$688.19, and for its costs herein in the sum of \$6.00. That the undersigned also claims a lien on the respective real estate above described for the respective amounts above last set out.
