

Notice of location of Lurotz claim, "Badger"

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, a citizen of the United States, over the age of twenty-one years, on the 14th day of Sept-1896, discovered a vein or lode of Lurotz or sand rock in place bearing Gold, Silver and Lead within the limits of the claim hereby located, and bore this 18 day of Sept-1896, under and in accordance with the Revised Statute of the United States, located fifteen hundred and one feet of this vein or lode in length, with surface ground, thirty hundred feet in width on each side of the center of said lode, situated in the Bald Mountain Mining District, County of Shoshone and State of Idaho, and known as the Badger Mining Claim and extending fifteen hundred feet to and from this Notice at the discovery or prospect shaft: the exterior boundaries of the claim being distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

This Mine or prospect is located at Point 600 feet South West from Spirit Lake & 300 feet North East from a high cliff and starts from discovery post and runs 300 feet in South Eastly to corner post, thence 1000 feet in a North Eastly course to corner post thence 300 feet North Westly course to center, and last thence 300 feet in North Westly course to corner post thence 1000 feet in South Westly course to corner post, thence 300 feet in a South Eastly to place of Beginning. The lode at deep spurs angles and departs, and that I intend to hold and work said above described claim as provided by the local laws, and the customs and rules of miners, and mining Statute and laws of the United States.
