

Notice of Location of Franklin Mine by John C. Franklin

To whom it may concern:

Notice is hereby given that I the undersigned, Citizen of the United States, over the age of 21 years, having complied with all the requirements of Chapter 6, Article 152 of the Revised Statutes of the United States and all the local laws, customs and regulations, have located a quartz claim extending 1500 lines feet along this lode or vein, to be known as the "Franklin" claim. Situated in the Copper Creek mining District, Deane County, State of Washington, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at this notice, on small Cedar tree growing on left bank of Canyon Creek, and running North 300 ft. to stake marked N.E. corner of Franklin claim, thence 1000 ft. West to stake marked N.W. corner of Franklin claim, thence 300 ft. South to stake marked S.E. corner of Franklin claim, continuing 300 ft. to stake marked S.W. corner of Franklin claim, thence 1500 ft. East to stake marked E. corner of Franklin claim, thence North 300 ft. to place of beginning. This claim is situated on the headwaters of Canyon Creek and lies West of the "Silver Lode" claim.
