Notice is hereby given that we the undersigned, Citizens of the United States, over the age of twenty, and years, having complied with all the requirements of Chapter 6 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes of the United States and the Local Mining Laws, rules and customs have located a Lode Claim on this lode or vein: to be known as the "Silver Lure" claim, extending 1000 linear ft along said lode or vein: Situated in the Upper Creek Mining District, Skamania County, State of Washington: and is more particularly described, as follows:
