

Notice of location of Baby Alice lode by John Fickler
To whom it may concern:

Notice is hereby given that I the undersigned citizen of the United States, over the age of twenty one years having complied with all the requirements of Chap. 6, of Title 32 of the Revised Statute of the United States and the local mining laws, rules and regulations, have located a lode claim on this lode or vein to be known as the "Baby Alice" claim - extending 1000 linear feet along said lode or vein, situated in the Copper Creek Mining District, Seamonie County, State of Washington, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at Larch tree, on left bank of stream and running 300 ft. E. N. E. to stake marked N. E. corner of "Baby Alice" claim; thence S. S. E. 1000 ft. to stake marked S. E. corner of "Baby Alice" claim; thence 300 ft. W. S. W. to stake marked S. corner of "Baby Alice" claim; containing 300 ft. to stake marked S. W. corner of "Baby Alice" claim; thence 1000 ft. N. N. W. to stake marked N. W. corner of "Baby Alice" claim; thence 300 ft. E. N. E. to place of beginning, this claim extends along and includes the upper part of the left fork of Bowling Creek and lies South of the "Fathman" claim and east of the Santa Lucia claim.
