Notice is hereby given that I, the undersigned citizen of the United States, over the age of 21 years having complied with all the requirements of Chapter 6, of Title 32, of the Revised Statutes of the United States and the local mining laws, rules and customs, have located a lode claim on this lode or vein, to be known as the "Calamont" claim extending 1000 linear feet along said lode or vein; situated in the Copper Creek Mining District, Idamarua County, State of Washington; and more particularly described as follows:
