Notice is hereby given that Conrad Berg, of Portland, Oregon, claims a lien upon a lot of railroad ties and lumber, being property of said Coulter and Wilson, which was cut and sawed in said County of Multnomah and at a place known and named Home Valley which said ties and lumber were cut and prepared by said claimant, Conrad Berg. This lien is for work, labor and service rendered by said Conrad Berg on said ties and lumber between the first day of September 1908 and the 24th day of October 1908 at the special instance and request of the said Coulter and Wilson during which time he worked for the period of 48 days as hereinafter at the agreed wages of \$3.00 per day thereby earning the sum of \$144.00.

That this sum has not been paid nor any portion thereof nor has been received the sum of \$28.80 for board, and the sum of \$2.00 as hospital bill and the further sum of \$1.05 due the commissary department, and that there is due and owing to the said Conrad Berg the full sum of \$175.85. That said labor was so performed upon said ties and lumber between the first day of September 1908 and the 24th day of October, 1908, said thirty days have not elapsed since said first date.
