Notice is hereby given that Nathan Stogdill of Spokane being State of Washington, claims a lien upon a lot of hay, being about ten tons in quantity which was cut or unsupervised in said County and State and which is now in bales and lying on an island commonly known as Boulders Island about one mile east of Coeur d'Alene along the line of the Spokane, Pendleton & Seattle Railway in said County, for labor performed, and materials rendered in harvesting and bridging said hay; that the name of the owner or reputed owner is W. T. Elsworth; that he employed said claimant to perform such labor and render such materials upon the following terms and conditions: to-wit: That said W. T. Elsworth agreed to pay said claimant for such labor and materials that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said claimant who performed labor upon and rendering in harvesting and bridging said hay for a period of about fifty seven days, that said work and materials were so performed and rendered upon said hay between the second day of June 1909 and the 31st day of July 1909 and forty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimants demand for said services is \$60.50; that no just thereof has been paid except \$5.00 and there is now due and owing unpaid thereon after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$55.50 which amount he claims a lien upon said hay. The said claimant also claims a lien on all said hay now owned by said W. T. Elsworth of said County to secure payment for the work and labor performed in harvesting and bridging ^{Nathan} ~~the~~ hay herein described.
