

Notice of Location of Lode Mining Claim
To whom it may concern:

Notice is hereby given that I, the undersigned, Citizen of the United States, over the age of 21 years, having complied with all the requirements of Chapter 6 of Title 52, of the Revised Statute of the United States and the local mining laws, rules and regulations, have located a Lode Claim on the lode or vein, to be known as the "Jennie Frances" claim extending 1500 linear feet along said lode or vein situated in the "Copper Peak" Mining District, Seaman's County, State of Washington; and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Notice, on big fir tree on right bank of "Jacks Creek", and running East 300 ft to stake marked N.E. corner of Jennie Frances claim; thence South 1000 ft to stake marked S.E. corner of Jennie Frances claim; thence West 300 ft to stake marked S.W. corner of Jennie Frances claim; continuing 300 ft to stake marked N.W. corner of Jennie Frances claim; thence North 1500 ft to stake marked N.E. corner of Jennie Frances claim; thence East 300 ft to place of beginning.

This claim is situated on the bedrock of Jacks Creek and lies South of the "Antimony" claim.
