This Indenture made and entered unto this 31st day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty between the Oregon Steam Navigation Company of Portland Oregon, A corporation duly incorporated and organized under the laws of the State of Oregon, party of the first part and the Oregon Railway and Navigation Company of Portland Oregon, a like corporation duly incorporated and organized under the laws of the State of Oregon party of the Second part, Witnesseth

That said party of the first part, the said Oregon Steam Navigation Company, under pursuant to, and by virtue of the power and authority conferred upon it, and invested in it, by the laws of the State of Oregon, and pursuant to, and by *Resolutions duly passed at a meeting of* authority of its Stock holders, duly called and held at its office in Portland Oregon on the 31st day of March, A.D. 1880, and of Resolutions of its Board of Directors duly passed at a meeting of said Board duly held at the office of said Company on the 31st day of March 1880, among other things authorizing the sale and conveyance of the property hereinafter described to the party of the second part, and in consideration of the sum of Seven hundred and ten thousand Dollars \$710,000 00/100 in United States Gold Coin, to it in hand paid by the party of the second
