

Lien of Williard Landfare vs E. M. Benham & Barff

Williard Landfare, Claimant

E. M. Benham & Barff, owners

Notice is hereby given that Williard Landfare of Skamania County State of Washington, claims a lien upon logs and boom being about Two Hundred Thousand feet of logs and One Thousand lineal feet of boom and in quantity which men cut in Skamania County, State of Washington are marked thus L and are now lying part on the banks of and part in Wind River, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in cooking for the logging hands and in work upon the said logs and boom that the name of the owner or reputed owner is E. M. Benham and Barff; that E. M. Benham employed said Williard Landfare to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions to wit: that said E. M. Benham agreed to pay the said Williard Landfare for such labor and assistance reasonable sum that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said Williard Landfare, who performed labor upon and assisted in work on and concerning said logs and boom for the period of more than four months; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said logs and boom between the 15th day of November 1897 and the 24th day of March 1898 and thirty days have not elapsed since the time limited for the filing of this lien; that the amount of claimants demand for said service is Seventy Five Dollars. That no part has been paid except Five Dollars; that there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of seventy dollars in which amount he claims a lien upon said logs and boom, now owned by said E. M. Benham and Barff to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing said logs and boom herein described
