Notice is hereby given that on the 27th day of Sept. 1909, O. W. Christensen, at the request of L. J. Klemm, president and manager of the Palla Rock Lumber Company, commenced to perform labor for said Palla Rock Lumber Company a corporation, in its saw mill and planing mill at the corner, Main and Third, Washington, at the agreed wage of \$3.50 per day and that between said date and February 25th instant, Christensen performed 77.5 days labor under said contract amounting in all to \$271.25 and as part of said sum has been paid except \$72.00 and that there is now due and unpaid the sum of \$199.25 after deducting all joint credits and offsets, and that the performance of said labor caused on January 25th 1910 the sum and amount O.
