

Notice of Location of Bernice Mine by J. Ross Linnox

Notice of Location of "Little Nell" Mine by Thomas Carolan

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six (6) of Title Thirty-two Revised Statutes of the United States and the local mining laws, rules and regulations, has located the "Little Nell" Gold and silver bearing quartz lode, situated in Skamania County, Wash., described as follows. Beginning at the discovery post (a vine maple tree), at first outcropping of lode at the source of a small unnamed creek on Northwesterly slope of Dole Trail Mountain, being the first creek emptying into Shult Fork Lewis river above mouth of Canyon Creek, and running thence easterly three hundred (300) feet, thence North, fifteen hundred (1500) feet thence easterly six hundred (600) feet, thence southeasterly fifteen hundred (1500) feet, thence easterly three hundred (300) feet to place of beginning.
