

Notice of Location of Fortune mine by Thomas Carolan
 Notice is hereby given that the undersigned
 having complied with the requirements of Chapter
 Six (6) of Title thirty two of the Revised Statutes of the
 United States, and the local mining laws, rules and reg-
 ulations has located the "Fortune" gold and silver bearing
 quartz lode situated in Skamania County, Washington,
 described as follows: Beginning at the discovery point
 (a hemlock tree about eight inches in diameter,) on center
 of lode on a small unnamed creek, having its source on
 the Northwesterly slope of Dale Trail Mountain, and being
 the first emptying into South Fork Lewis river about the
 mouth of Canyon creek, and about fifteen hundred feet
 below the "Little Well" lode, running thence Easterly three
 hundred (300) feet, thence Northwesterly fifteen hundred (1500)
 feet, thence Westerly six hundred (600) feet, thence South-
 westerly fifteen hundred (1500) feet, thence Easterly three hun-
 dred (300) feet to place of beginning.
