

# Notice of Location of "Little Nell" By J. Ross Tennor

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six (6) of Title Thirty-two (32) of the Revised Statutes of the United States, and the local mining laws rules and regulations, has located the "Little Nell" Gold and Silver bearing quartz lode, situated in Skamania County, Wash. described as follows: Beginning at the discovery point (a vine maple tree) at first outcropping of lode at the source of a small unnamed creek on Northwesterly slope of Dale Prairie Mountain, being the first creek emptying into South Fork Lewis river above mouth of Canyon Creek, and running thence easterly (300) three hundred feet thence southerly fifteen hundred (1500) feet thence easterly six hundred (600) feet thence northerly fifteen hundred (1500) feet thence easterly three hundred (300) feet to place of beginning. Notice of Location of McFinley Mine by F. M. Wood to whom it may concern. Notice is hereby given that the undersigned Citizen of the United States, having complied with all the requirements of Chapter 6 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes of the United States, and the local mining laws rules and regulations, has located a lode of Gold bearing quartz described as follows: Beginning at location notice on the first creek emptying into South Fork of Lewis River, above Canyon Creek, in Skamania County, Washington thence running West 300 feet, thence South 1500 feet thence East 600 feet, thence North 1500 feet, thence East 300 feet to place of beginning, all corners and side lines marked, running to the line of the Fortune on the west, and that of the Corliss on the East.
