of \$116.50 after deducting all just credits and offsets. The sum of the money
employed the said S. Billington, claimed as above named, and who acted for and on
behalf of said corporation in employing claimant as foreman, secretary of
the said corporation, and other terms and conditions of said employment where that
the claimant, S. Billington was to perform work, labor and services for the above
named corporation in the operation of its sawmill situated on the land hereinbefore
described as a corporate, in and about said mill place, at the stipulated wage of \$3.00
per day for each and every day said claimant performed said work and labor; that the
claimant, S. Billington began the performance of his work for said company and
ended upon the employment herein referred to on the 31st day of December 1909 and
the date of his last service in said employment was the 8th day of February 1910,
that said claim is made for and sum of money for thirty nine days work performed
by him within the months of February and January 1910, ended December and January
1909, at the agreed wage, as stated above, and as for the sum of \$116.00 after
deducting all just credits and offsets. The real property upon which this claim
is filed and the franchise and the earnings therefrom upon which this lien is filed
and all the real and personal property of said company upon which this lien is filed is
