

Notice of Location of "Wonder" Mine by W. S. Harvey
 To Whom it may Concern: Notice is hereby
 That W. S. Harvey a citizen of the United States of America, over the age of twenty-one years, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States and of all other Mining laws thereof, and of the State of Wash. and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners, did on the 28 day of Jan AD 1897, locate, and by this notice do hereby locate a Quartz Claim, known as the "Wonder" Lode or Mining Claim, said claim having been discovered the 28 day of Jan 1897, and do claim (fifty hundred linear feet on this lode, lode or vein bearing mineral in place, by six hundred feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dips, spurs and angles, and all other veins or lodes, the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries) (Twenty acres of place - mining ground). Situated in the first creek North of Copper Creek in Copper Creek Co. County of Skamania State of Wash. said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit: Starting at the Center of said Creek running 1000 ft in a North-by direction from Center stake at South end to Center stake at north end and 300 ft back away from center line as follows: Starting at Center stake at South end running 200 ft East then 1000 ft North then 500 ft West to Center stake at north end then 300 ft West to corner stake then 1000 ft South to corner stake then 300 ft East to stake of commencement.

And I intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners and the Mining Laws of the United States and of the State of Wash.
