

Notice of Location of Flora Claim by Wm F. Colgate

To whom it may concern: Notice is hereby given that I the undersigned Citizen of the United States over the age of 21 years having complied with Sections 6 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes of the United States and the local mining laws rules and customs have this day located a Lode Claim on this side or vein to be known as the Flora Claim extending 1500 feet in a South Easterly direction along said Lode or vein situated in the Copper Creek mining District Ramsey County State of Washington and more particularly described as follows

Beginning at this notice on large Hemenway Tree on South Bank of Creek and running 200 ft. East-North East to Stake marked North East corner Flora Claim thence South South East 1500 ft. to Stake marked South East corner Flora Claim thence West South West 200 feet to Stake marked South Center Flora Claim continuing 500 feet to Stake marked South West Corner Flora Claim thence North North West 1500 feet to Stake marked North West corner Flora Claim, thence East North East 200 feet to place of beginning. This Notice is on the East fork of Twine Creek about 1000 feet from forks of Creek adjoining Belmont Claim on the North and All Horn Claim on the East, Located Jan 22nd 1897
