 To whom it may concern. Notice is hereby
 given that I the undersigned Citizen of the United States
 over the age of twenty one years having complied with
 Chapter 6 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes of the United
 States and the local mining laws rules and customs have
 this day located a lode Claim on the vein or lode
 to be known as the "Belmont-Clair" extending 1000 feet in
 a North Westerly direction along said vein or lode situated
 in the Copper Creek mining district Skamania County State
 of Washington and described as follows. Beginning at this
 notice on large Hemlock Tree on South bank of Creek and
 running 200 feet East North East to stake marked South East
 corner Belmont-Clair thence North North West 1500 ft. to
 stake marked North East corner Belmont-Clair thence
 West South West 200 feet to stake marked North Center
 Belmont-Clair continuing 300 feet to stake marked North
 West corner Belmont-Clair thence South South East 1500
 feet to stake marked South West corner Belmont-Clair
 thence East North East 300 ft. to place of beginning this
 notice is on the East fork of Coulter Creek about 1000 ft.
