Notice is hereby given that the undersigned T. J. Scott, of Underwood, Skamania County, Washington, claims a lien upon a quantity of lumber being about twenty-seven thousand feet, which was cut and manufactured in the county of Skamania, state of Washington, and is unmarked about twenty-five thousand feet consisting of dimension lumber being piled in and around the mill of the Hood Lumber company upon the land of the claimant, at or near Hood, Washington, about two thousand feet piled at the siding at Hood, Washington near the store of the Hook's Mercantile Company. This lien is claimed for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in cutting and manufacturing the said lumber. That the owner or reputed owner is the Hood Lumber Company, a co-partnership composed of O. A. Perry, R. H. Young and L. M. Booth; that the said Hood Lumber company employed the said T. J. Scott upon the following terms and conditions,

The said Hood Lumber company agreed to pay the said T. J. Scott for such labor and assistance the sum of \$2.50 per

day, that the said contract has been faithfully performed and rendered upon the said lumber between the 1st day of September 1909 and the 16th. day of May 1910, and the rendition of the said service was closed on the 16th. day of May 1910 and that thirty days have not elapsed since that time. That the services for which this lien is claimed were performed between January 1st. 1910 and the said 16th. day of May 1910 and that the amount of claimant's demand therefor is \$160.60, that no part thereof has been paid excepting the sum of \$58.00. That the said Hood Lumber company owed the claimant for the said services performed between September 1st. 1909 and January 1st. 1910 the sum of \$86.15, all of which has been paid. That there is now due and owing this claimant the sum of \$102.60 for services as aforesaid for which amount he claims a lien upon said lumber.

The said T. J. Scott, also claims a lien upon the said lumber for the timber from which the same were cut, which said timber was furnished by the claimant to the said Hood Lumber company upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

The said Hood Lumber company agreed to pay claimant the sum of \$1.00 per thousand feet for all timber furnished by the claimant, and taken from claimant's land by the said Hood Lumber company. That the said Hood Lumber company cut and took from claimant's land 98,500 feet of timber. That the said timber is worth the sum of \$98.50 and that there has been none of the said amount paid. That there is due and remaining unpaid for said stumpage the said sum of \$98.50 over and above all just credits and offsets, for which this lien is claimed.

Claimant also claims a lien on all the said lumber now owned by the said Hood Lumber company for furnishing the said timber and for labor and assistance rendered in the manufacture of the lumber herein described.
