

Notice of Location of New York Lode by Rupert Harrison
 To whom it may concern. Notice is hereby
 given that I, the undersigned citizen of the United States,
 over the age of 21 years, having complied with all the require-
 ments of Chapter 6 of Title 32, of the Revised Statutes of the
 United States, and the local laws, customs, & regulations,
 have located a Quartz Claim on this lode or vein, to be known
 as the "New York Lode" claim, extending for a distance of 1500
 linear ft. along said lode or vein, situated in the Copper Creek
 Mining District, Skamania County, State of Washington, and more
 particularly described as follows:

Beginning at this notice on large birch tree on left bank of
 Porcupine Gulch, and running 300 ft. in a direction thirty de-
 grees South of East to a stake marked N.E. corner of "New York Lode"
 claim: thence 1500 ft. in a direction 80° West of South to stake on
 bank of Canyon Creek marked: witness to S.E. corner of New York
 Lode claim, said corner being in center of stream: thence
 down center of said stream for a distance of 600 ft. to a point
 opposite a stake marked: witness to S.W. corner of "New York
 Lode" claim; thence 1500 ft. in a direction 80° East of North to stake
 marked N.W. corner of "New York Lode" claim: thence 300 ft.
 in a direction 80° South of East to place of beginning.

This claim is situated on the lower part of Porcupine Gulch,
 lies South of the "Cora Belle" claim, and has Canyon Creek for
