Notice is hereby given that on the eighth day of August 1910 at the request of H.W. Henslin and J.C. Whitehead the above named claimant commenced to perform labor upon that certain building or structure consisting of a two story frame building situated upon the following described premises to-wit: The northwest one quarter of the northeast quarter of section nineteen Township three north, range ten east of Walla Walla subdivision, in Skamania County, Washington of which property H.W. Henslin and J.C. Whitehead are the reported owners. The performance of which labor came on the seventeenth day of September 1910 that all of said land hereinabove described is necessary for the completion and occupation of said building or structure, that said labor performed was to the value of one hundred and fifty two dollars; that ninety days have not elapsed since said sum was due. For which labor, the claimant, unassisted, claims a lien upon the property herein described and the building situated thereon for the said sum of one hundred and fifty two dollars.
