Notice is hereby given that on the dates hereinafter set forth opposite the claims herein described, the claimants at the request of Alden Hefgman commenced to perform labor upon the real estate of said Alden Hefgman in Blaine County, Washington, which real estate is situated upon the following described land, to-wit: $N\frac{1}{2}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 36 T₃₆ S₄ R_{7E} E. 11. all of which property the owner or reputed owner is Alden Hefgman. That the said labor consisted in building the said building containing the following therefor and placing machinery thereon and that said labor ceased on the 14th day of October 1910. That the said A. Fowler commenced to perform the said labor thereon on the 14th day of August 1910 and ceased to perform the same on the 14th day of October 1910; that the total value of said work was \$187.00 of which the owner of \$113.00 has been paid, and that there is now due the said A. Fowler thereon the sum of \$74.00. That the said Gus Anderson began work August 28, 1910 and ceased work thereon October 14th 1910 that the total value of said work is \$60.00 of which \$20.14 has been paid leaving a balance of \$39.86 therefor. That said S. Clark commenced work on 21st day of September 1910 and ceased said work thereon on the 14th day of October 1910, that the value thereof is \$52.20 of which \$28.25 has been paid and that there is now due thereon \$23.95. That the said J. E. Wood commenced the said labor on the 14th day of August 1910 and ceased to labor thereon on the 14th day of August 1910, that the value of such owner is worth \$100.31 of which the owner of \$31.99 has been paid and that there is now due thereon a balance of \$68.32. For which labor the undersigned claims a lien upon the property herein described with the said owner of \$74.00, \$39.86, \$23.95 and \$68.32, in the total sum of \$182.53, all of which claims are hereby asserted, and this filed by J. E. Wood on behalf of said claimants.
