Notice of Location of First William Lode by Hugo District

In compliance with the U.S. Mining laws and the regulations of the Cispus and St. Helens Mining District I located the First William Lode. The discovery is about one half of a mile above the Grizzly Lode on Grizzly Creek a tributary to the North Fork River and is supposed to be in Kamama Co Wash in the St. Helens and Cispus Mining District. Soundings: From place of discovery 300 feet South 15° West thence 1000 feet South 75° East, thence 600 feet North 15° East, thence 1500 feet North 75° West, thence 300 feet South 15° West to place of beginning.
