Notice is hereby given, that George Weist of Stevenson, Skamania County, Washington, claims a lien upon a certain lot of fir saw logs, being about 200,000 feet in quantity, which were cut in Skamania County, State of Washington, and are marked thus not marked and are now lying in the woods on John Wacker's place more particularly described as follows, to-wit: $\text{SW } \frac{1}{4}$ of $\text{S. All of said horses being in possession of Thomas Ryan, Skamania Co. Wash. 3 sets harness, 1 saddle, 1 blacksmiths outfit, 4 30 lbs skid oil, 2 kegs, 1 pair shoes, 6 pair spreaders, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ pair coupling dogs, 2 blocks, 125 feet cable, 5 cross cut saws, 1 falling saw, 6 wedges, 5 sledges, 18 shovels, 116 feet $\frac{1}{2}$ inch rope, 1 grind stone, 2 pick blocks, 3 pick axes, 10 grub hoes, 1 foot adg, 2 chains, 9 peaveys, 18 axes, 1 bone stone, 12 saw handles, 1 pair skidding logs, 100 lbs blacksmith coal, 1 cooking range, furniture and utensils, and all other personal property said company used in the operation of its business in said County and State. All of said property situate in said company's logging camp near Stevenson, Washington; also on franchise, earnings, contracts and the logging road used in the operation of its business; also upon all real estate

owned by said company in said county and state, said real estate being the north half of the S. E. C. of Henry, Shepard and wife as described in Book 7 pages 272 & 276 record of mortgages of said county and state; for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in manufacturing said logs and the construction of said logging road and logging plant of said Company that the name of the owner or reputed owner is the said J. N. Russell, B. J. Russell, W. J. Smith and J. H. Parelius, doing business under the firm name of Russell Smith Co. that Robert Manary, foreman and agent of said Russell Smith Co. employed said George Weist to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit: at the rate of \$1.⁷⁵ per day for all labor performed.

The said Russell Smith Co. by their foreman and agent Robert Manary agreed to pay the said George Weist for such labor and assistance as hereinbefore set forth; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said George Weist who performed labor upon and assisted in manufacturing said saw-logs and in building and operating said log-way and logging plant for the period of seventeen days; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said logs and upon said logging way and upon said logging plant between the 5th day of July 1899 and the 25th day of July 1899 and the rendition of said service was closed on the 25 day of July 1899; and Thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said service is \$29.⁷⁵ Dollars; That no part thereof has been paid except ----- Dollars and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets the sum of \$29.⁷⁵ Dollars, in which amount he claims a lien upon said logs and upon said personal property and said real property hereinbefore described. The said George Weist also claims a lien on all said logs, franchise, earnings, contracts logging road and all personal and real property now owned by said J. N. Russell, B. J. Russell, W. J. Smith and J. H. Parelius as partners under the firm name of Russell Smith Co. in said Skamania County, Washington, to secure payment for the work and labor performed as herein described

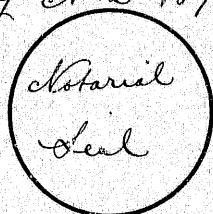
