Where it is hereby given that on the — day of December, 1910, B. O. Youmans, at the request of Orin A. Perry, acting for himself and as agent for the owners and requested owners of the property hereinbefore described, commenced to perform labor upon and to furnish material to be used in that certain one story garden frame single roofed cottage containing four rooms, one bath room and a front closed porch, facing to the west and built and constructed as last amended survey (16) and the north half of (17) of lot number one hundred (17) in Block numbered five (5) in the original plat of books, American Lumber, State of Washington, recorded to and accepted by the official plat of said town of Brooks and on file and of record in the office of the Auditor of the State of Washington of which property the present, or requested owners are Orin A. Perry and B. O. Perry his wife, Harry Rogers and — Rogers his wife, and the Brooks Lumber and Company a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Washington, said material being plywood siding and the cutting of same into planks and said said labor being the labor of not less than six men, the performance of which labor and the furnishing of said material cost on the 22nd day of December 1910, that said labor so performed was of the value of \$81.75 and the value of said material so furnished was the sum of \$106.25, making a total value of both labor and material of \$188.00, for which labor and material the undersigned claims a lien upon the property herein described for the sum of one hundred and eighty eight (\$188.00) Dollars; that said claimant did on the day of the delivery of said material and to the owners of said building and thereupon a full, true and correct statement in writing of the said material as required by the laws of the State of Washington; that claimant has expended the sum of \$15.00 in preparing and filing this notice of lien in which further amount he claims a lien upon said property.
