In compliance with the U.S. Mining Laws and the regulations of the Census and St. Helens Mining District I located the Mt. Rainer Lode. The discovery is on a small creek on the east slope of the Southern range about 1 mile below the Chicago Lode said creek is a tributary to the North Fork River in Skamania Co. Wash in the Census and St. Helens Mining District.

Boundaries: From place of discovery 300 feet South 25° West, thence 1500 feet South 67° East, thence 600 feet North 25° East, thence North 67° West 1500 feet, thence 600 feet South 25° West to place of beginning. Located Jan 11th 97
