NOW KNOW YE, THAT THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PREMISES, HAS GIVEN AND GRANTED, AND BY THESE PRESENTS DOES GIVE AND GRANT, UNTO THE SAID G. B. MC LEOD, AND TO HIS HEIRS, THE LANDS ABOVE DESCRIBED: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, TOGETHER WITH ALL THE RIGHTS, PRIVILEGES, IMMUNITIES, AND APPURTENANCES, OF WHATSOEVER NATURE, THEREUNTO BELONGING, UNTO THE SAID G. B. MC LEOD, AND TO HIS HEIRS AND ASSIGNS BELONGING, UNTO THE SAID G. B. MC LEOD, AND TO HIS HEIRS AND ASSIGNS FOREYER: SUBJECT TO ANY VESTED AND ACCRUED WATER RIGHTS FOR MINING, AGRIFOREYER: SUBJECT TO ANY VESTED AND ACCRUED WATER RIGHTS TO DITCHES AND RESERVOIRS USED IN CONNECTION WITH SUCH WATER RIGHTS, AS MAY BE REDOGNATION OF COURT RIZED AND ACKNOWLEDGED BY THE LOCAL CUSTOMS.
