Know all men by these presents, that I <sup>Elwood</sup> Smith of above County,  
and Territory, am held and firmly bound unto W. R. Reynolds, in the penal sum  
of Two Hundred Dollars, lawful money of the United States and for the payment,  
thereof, to be well and truly made, I bind myself, my heirs, and assigns, jointly  
and severally firmly by these presents.

Whereas the said Elwood Smith, has this day sold to the said W.R. Reynolds  
the undivided one half, of the South West quarter of the North West quarter. The  
West half of South West 4 and Lots 3, 4, & 5, in section Two, Township 2, North of  
Range 7 East Willamette Meridian, containing, 154 20/100 acres, for the sum of Two  
Hundred Dollars to be paid on the 20th day of February, A. D. 1882..

Now the conditions of this bond is such, in addition to the foregoing  
that if the said Elwood Smith, his heirs or assigns, shall well and truly  
execute to the said W.R. Reynolds, his heirs, or assigns, a good and sufficient deed  
to the within mentioned land upon a compliance of his part with the conditions of  
this bond, then this bond to be void, otherwise to remain in full force. Witness
