Notice of Location of Quartz Claim

Wiley Lode.

Notice is hereby given, that the undersigned a citizen of the United States, over the age of twenty one years, on the Eighth (8th) day of May 1881, discovered a vein, or lode of quartz or sand rock in place bearing gold silver, and lead, within the limits of the claim hereby located, and have this the Twenty ninth (29th) day of June 1881, under and in accordance with the revised Statues of the United States, located fifteen hundred linear feet of this vein, or lode in length with surface ground, three hundred feet in width, on each side of the centre of said lode situated in ^{mining District} Skamania ^{of Skamania} County, and Territory of Washington, and known as the R. Arnold Mining Claim, and extending fifteen hundred feet to and from this notice at the discovery of prospect shaft . The exterior boundaries of this claim being distinctly marked by reference to natural objects, or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows, "To wit." Beginning in the centre of said lode at the discovery Shaft, and on a line of mining claim of E.G. Bayers, and running thence Southerly, Three Hundred feet (S300ft) to a Corner, and thence at right angles Easterly fifteen Hundred feet (E1500 ft) to a corner, Thence at right angles Northerly Six Hundred feet (N.600 ft) to a corner, and thence Westerly at right angles fifteen Hundred feet (W. 1500 ft) to a corner, and thence Southerly Three Hundred feet (S300 ft) to the place of beginning, and that I intend to hold and work said above described claim as provided by the local laws the customs, and rules of miners and mining Statues and laws of the United States.
