
To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, There is now deposited in the Bureau of Land Management of the United States, Clear List No. 337 of the Northern Pacific Railway Company, approved by the Manager of the Land Office, Division of Field Services at Washington, District of Columbia, February 15, 1963, showing that the land described as follows:

Willamette Meridian, Washington.

Sec. 7, Lots 5 and 6;

Sec. 31, Lots 5, 6, 7, 8 and 10,

containing 280.81 acres, is within the primary limits of the said Company's grant made by the Act of July 2, 1864 (13 Stat. 365) and the Joint Resolution of May 31, 1870 (16 Stat. 378); that the said Company sold the said tracts to such an innocent purchaser for value as is contemplated by Section 321-b, Part II, Title III of the Act of September 18, 1940 (54 Stat. 898-954; 49 U.S.C. sec. 65) and that the said Company has listed said tracts for patenting under the provisions of the acts above cited:

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and pursuant to the above cited Acts of Congress, HAS GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DOES GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said Northern Pacific Railway Company, its successors and assigns, the tracts of land listed as aforesaid and hereinabove described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tracts with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Northern Pacific Railway Company, and to its successors and assigns forever.
