NOTICE OF LOCATION OF QUARTZ CLAIM

Mountain Queen Lode.

Notice is hereby given, that the undersigned, citizens of the United States over the age of Twenty One years on the Eighth 8th day of May 1881, discovered a vein or lode of quartz, or sand rock in place bearing Gold, Silver, and Lead, within the limits of the claim hereby located, and have this the Twenty Ninth (29th) day of June 1881, under and in accordance with the Revised Statues of the United States, located fifteen hundred linear feet, of this vein or lode in length, with surface ground three hundred feet in width, on each side of the centre of said lode, situated in the Skamania Mining District, County of Skamania Territory of Washington, and known as the Silver Star, Mining Claim, and extending fifteen hundred to and from this notice at the discovery or prospect shaft; the exterior boundaries of this claim being distinctly marked by reference to natural objects, or permanent monuments and more particularly described as follows "To wit." Beginning at the prospect, in the centre of said lode at the discovery shaft thereof on the West side of Canyon Creek, and running thence Northerly three hundred feet, to a corner, and thence at right angles Westerly fifteen hundred feet, (Westerly 1500 ft) to a corner, thence at right angles Southerly Six Hundred feet (S.600 ft) to a corner at right angles.
