Notice is hereby given, that theundersigned a citizen of the United States, over the age of Twenty One years, on the Eighth (8th) day of May 1881, discovered a vein, or lode of quartz or sand rock, in place bearing Gold, Silver and Lead, within the limits of the claim hereby located, and have this the Twenty ninth (29th) day of June 1881, under, and in accordance with the revised Statues of the United States, located fifteen hundred linear feet of this vein, or lode in length, with surface ground three hundred feet in width, on each side of the centre of said lode, situated in the Skamania Mining District, County of Skamania, and Territory of Washington, and known as the Silver Star mining Claim, and extending fifteen hundred feet to, and from this notice, at the discovery, or prospect shaft the exterior boundaries of this claim being distinctly marked by reference to natural objects, or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows, "towit" Beginning at a point in the centre of said Lode, at the discovery shaft, thereof and running thence along the line of said Byars & Steen and on the Eastern end line of the mining claim of Byars & Steen claim Northerly Three Hundred feet (N. 300 ft) to a corner Thence Easterly fifteen hundred feet (E. 1500 ft) to a corner.
