

To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:



WHEREAS, an Order of the authorized officer of the Bureau of Indian Affairs is now deposited in the Bureau of Land Management, directing that a fee simple patent issue to the claimant L. Sterling Hanel, pursuant to the Act of June 25, 1910 (36 Stat. 855), for the following described land:

The area described contains 40 acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, on file in the Bureau of Land Management:

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, HAS GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DOES GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said claimant and to the heirs of the said claimant the Land above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said claimant and to the heirs and assigns of the said claimant forever.

There is reserved from the lands hereby granted a right-of-way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.

This patent is subject to the reservation of all oil, gas and other minerals, except sand and gravel, to the United States in trust for the beneficial owners thereof, their heirs and assigns.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, the undersigned authorized officer of the Bureau of Land Management, in accordance with the provisions of the Act of June 17, 1948 (62 Stat., 476), has, in the name of the United States, caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the Bureau to be hereunto affixed.
