To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:


WHEREAS, the Northern Pacific Railway Company, being the owner of a certain tract of land situated and included within the limits of the Gifford Pinchot National Forest, Washington, has, under the provisions of the Act approved March 20, 1922 (42 Stat. 465), entitled "An Act to consolidate national forest lands", as amended by the Act of February 28, 1925 (43 Stat. 1090), as supplemented by the Act of June 11, 1960 (74 Stat. 205), reconveyed and relinquished the said tract to the United States and has, under the provisions of said Act, selected in lieu thereof the following described tract of land:

Willamette Meridian, Washington.

The area described contains 1,324.32 acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, on file in the Bureau of Land Management:

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, HAS GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DOES GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said Northern Pacific Railway Company, and to its successors, the tract above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Northern Pacific Railway Company, and to its successors and assigns forever; subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws, and decisions of courts; and there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right-of-way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.



IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, the undersigned authorized officer of the Bureau of Land Management, in accordance with the provisions of the Act of June 17, 1948 (62 Stat. 476), has, in the name of the United States, caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the Bureau to be hereunto affixed.

GIVEN under my hand, in Portland, Oregon, the TWENTY-THIRD day of JUNE in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and SIXTY-SIX and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and NINETIETH.
