

Labor Lien

F. R. Ridley, Plaintiff

Largest Gripper.

Notice is hereby given that F. R. Ridley of Skamania County, State of Washington, claims a lien on 689.75 cords of fire wood which was cut in Skamania County, State of Washington, and which is now lying on the following described land in Skamania County Washington to-wit: being a part of the largest Gripper land in Section 35 Township 3 North of Range 7 East of the Willamette Meridian, a distance of about two miles in a northwesterly direction from the Town of Steamer in said County; for labor performed upon and materials rendered in cutting, piling and preparing said wood for market, that the owner of the owner or reputed owner of said cordwood is largest Gripper, that said largest Gripper employed said claimant to perform such labor and rendered such materials upon the following terms and conditions to-wit: The said largest Gripper agreed to pay the said F. R. Ridley for such labor and materials the sum of \$1.25 per cord for each cut and every cord thereof so cut by claimant; that said work has been faithfully performed and fully completed with in the part of said F. R. Ridley, that said labor and materials were so performed and rendered upon said cordwood between the 20th day of October 1911 and the 15th day of April 1912, and the rendition of said services was closed on the 15th day of April 1912, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time, that the amount of claimant's demand for said services is \$862.20, that no part thereof has been paid except \$689.75 and that there is now due and owing upon thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$172.45 in which amount he claims a lien upon said cordwood. The said F. R. Ridley also claims a lien on all said cordwood now owned by said largest Gripper of said County, to secure the payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining and running the said cordwood herein described.
