

Notice of Location of Elsie Mine by Bigham & Munclon
 To whom it may concern: Notice is hereby given
 That we Charles W. Bigham and C. H. Munclon citizens of the
 United State of America, over the age of twenty-one years, having
 complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty-two
 of the Revised Statutes of the United State and of all other mining
 laws thereof and of the Stat of Utah and the local customs,
 laws, rules and regulations of miners, did, on the 25 day of Oct-
 AD 1896, locate, and by this notice do hereby locate a Lode Claim,
 known as the Elsie Lode or Mining Claim, said claim having
 been discovered the 25th day of Oct-1896, and do claim (fifteen
 hundred linear feet on the head, lode or vein bearing mineral
 in place, by six hundred feet in width, the same being three
 hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all
 dips, spurs and angles, and all other veins or lodes, the top or apex
 of which lie within said boundaries) (twenty acres of mining
 ground), situated in Copper Creek Dist. County of Kameewa Stat
 of Utah said location being described and distinctly marked by
 reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more
 particularly described as follows, to-wit:

This Claim is on Charles Creek south of Copper Creek
 it is a branch of Canyon Creek and this claim runs 1000 feet
 10 degrees E of S and 300 feet each way from center from where
 this notice is posted it is known as the Elsie mine and runs
 down the creek from this notice, and we intend to hold and
 work said claim in accordance with the local custom and
 rules of miners and the mining laws of the United State and of
