

Notice of Location of Bulger Lode by Munclon & Satterfield
 To whom it may concern, Notice is hereby given
 That Charles H. Munclon W.E. Satterfield a citizen of the United
 States of America, over the age of twenty-one years, having com-
 plied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty-two
 of the Revised Statutes of the United States and of all other mining
 laws thereof, and of the State of Washington and the local custom,
 laws, rules and regulations of miners, did, on the Sixth day of
 October A.D. 1896. locate, and by this Notice do hereby locate a
 Lode Claim, known as the Bulger Lode or Mining Claim.
 said claim having been discovered the Sixth day of October
 1896, and do claim (fifteen hundred linear feet on this lead, lode
 or vein bearing mineral in place, by six hundred feet in width,
 the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof,
 together with all dips, spurs and angles, and all other veins or
 bodies, the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries,
 (twenty acres of Mining ground), situated in Charles Creek
 County of Skamania State of Washington said location being de-
 scribed and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or
 permanent monuments, and more particularly described as fol-
 lows, to-wit:

And Old abandoned Claim Ridge
 Running North 20 degrees West on Creek known as Charles
 Creek. We locate Prospect Claim Running 1500 feet North
 10 Degrees West we locate this day and date and 300 feet
 each way from center. And we intend to hold and work
 said claim in accordance with the local custom and rules
 of miners and the Mining Laws of the United States, and of the
