

## BOOK C DEEDS AND MORTGAGES

MADE executed, and delivered by us, to the said Samuel B. Jones as aforesaid, have granted bargained, and sold and we do by these presents grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm, unto the said Samuel B. Jones, all of that certain lot or parcel of land lying and being situated at Lower Cascades, in the County of Skamania aforesaid and on what is known as Hamilton Island, and bounded as follows "towit".

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Beginning at the South West corner of the block upon which stands the Car House, belonging to the Cascade Rail Road Company, and on the line between Columbia City and the land owned by S. M. Hamilton, and Mary J. Hamilton and running thence, North thirty degrees and fifteen minutes West, One hundred and twenty feet to the center of the block upon which the said Car House stands, thence, South fifty nine degrees and forty five minutes West two hundred feet, thence South thirty degrees and fifteen minutes East to the line of the Cascade Rail Road Company's land, Thence, North thirty degrees and fifteen minutes West to the place of beginning. It being the same tract of land which was conveyed to the said Samuel B. Jones, by the deed of conveyance executed by us on the nineteenth day of March A. D. 1868 as aforesaid.

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Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditament and appurtenances therein, being or thereunto in anywise appertaining or belonging. To have and to hold the said above described and granted premises with the appurtenances, unto him the said Samuel B. Jones and unto his heirs and assigns to his and their own use and behoof forever.
