

Timberman's Lien

J. P. Barrett - Claimant

R. J. Vandenberg, Owner

Notice is hereby given that J. P. Barrett of Skamania County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon a quantity of four foot cordwood, being about 175 cords in quantity, which was cut in Skamania County, Washington, is unmarked except that the same is the ordinary fir cut and split cordwood 4 ft. long, which said cordwood is now lying in the vicinity of Hood Station on the Spokane, Portland & Seattle Railway, in the Eastern part of said Skamania County, about 75 cords thereof being in the woods, where cut on the land owned, or reputed to be owned by the above named R. J. Vandenberg, and the balance in the switch yard of the Spokane, Portland & Seattle Railway Co., at Hood station and the balance at the boat landing at said Hood station for labor performed in cutting, hauling and preparing said cordwood for market; that the name of the owner or reputed owner of said cordwood is R. J. Vandenberg; that C. M. Iman employed said J. P. Barrett to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to wit: to pay claimant \$2.50 per day and board at which claimant worked until July 20, and after July 20, 1912, at \$40.00 per month and board; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said J. P. Barrett, who performed labor upon and rendered assistance in and about cutting, hauling and preparing said cordwood for market for two months and twenty days; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said cordwood between the 6th day of June, 1912, and the 21st day of September, 1912; and the rendition of said service was closed on the 21st day of September, 1912, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said service is \$139.00; that no part thereof has been paid except the sum of \$8.75 and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$130.25 in which amount he claims a lien upon said cordwood. The said J. P. Barrett also claims a lien upon all said cordwood now owned by said R. J. Vandenberg of said county to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining and securing said cordwood as herein described.
