

Notice of Location of Santa Lucia Claim by Oscar A. Woster
 To whom it may concern. Notice is hereby given
 that I the undersigned Citizen of the United States over the
 age of twenty one years having complied with all the require-
 ments of Chapter 5, Title 32, of the Revised Statutes of the United
 States, and the local mining laws rules and customs have
 this day located a lode claim on this lode or vein to be known
 as the Santa Lucia Claim extending 1000 linear ft along said lode
 or vein, situated in the Copper Creek Mining District Adair
 County State of Washington and more particularly described as follows.

Beginning at the Notice on Monument tree on North bank of
 Bowlin Creek and running East North East 300 feet to stake marked
 North East corner Santa Lucia Claim thence South South East 150
 feet to stake marked South East corner Santa Lucia Claim thence
 thence South West 300 ft to stake marked South Center Santa Lucia
 Claim continuing 300 feet to stake marked South West corner
 Santa Lucia claim thence North North West 1000 feet to stake marked
 North West corner Santa Lucia claim thence East North East 300 ft
 to place of beginning. This claim is situated on Bowlin Creek
 about 1/4 mile below forks of said Creek and lying South South
