

Notice of location of Monterey claim by Wm. C. Oligor

To whom it may concern, Notice is hereby given that I the undersigned, Citizen of the United States, over the age of 21 years, having complied with all the requirements of Chapter 6. of Title 52. of the Revised Statutes of the United States and the local mining laws, rules and customs have located a Quartz Claim on the Lode or Vein to be known as the Monterey Claim extending 1000 linear feet along said Lode or Vein, situated in the "Copper Creek" Mining District Stanislaus County, State of Washington and more particularly described as follows.

Beginning at this Notice on Henlock tree on North Bank of Boulder Creek about 1/2 mile below forks of said creek and running East North East 300 ft to stake marked South East Corner Monterey Claim, thence running North North West 1000 feet to stake marked North East Corner Monterey Claim, thence running West South West 300 feet to fir tree marked North Center Monterey Claim continuing 300 feet to fir tree marked North East corner Monterey Claim thence running 1000 feet South South East to stake marked South West Corner Monterey Claim thence running East North East 300 ft to place of beginning. This Claim is situated on small Creek known as Boulder Creek or Boulder Gulch about 1/2 mile below forks of said creek and lies North of and joining Santa Lucia Claim.
